1	Use a private registered domain such as your name or company/website name.		
2	Ensure the domain does not include 'spam' words like money, make money or wealth.		
3	Use a 'name' for your FROM email address. Don't use info@ or admin@ instead use something like howard@howardfromgeorgia.com.		
4	Be consistent with the use of your selected FROM NAME.		
5	Never use spam or misleading subject lines. Also limit the use of special characters and emogis.		
6	Ensure your email content does not contain a massive amount of links. Likewise, be aware that certain domains used in your links may be blacklisted, thus making inboxing more difficult.		
7	Make your email content (and subject line) as 'unique' as possible. If you MUST use swipes, try to edit them as much as possible without altering the meaning of the message.		
8	Ensure your email disclaimer does not include any spam words.		
9	Be consistent with the number of emails you send from the beginning.		
10	Engage with your subscribers.		
11	Use MX Toolbox to do a MX Lookup https://mxtoolbox.com/SuperTool.aspx		
12	Remove all bounces emails from your autoresponder		
13	Segment people who have not opened your emails in 90 - 120 days.		
14	Remove this segment from your autoresponder - EVENTUALLY. Try tactics such as sending a re-engagement email series to this segment. You also may want to import these contacts into another autoresponder to test before deleting for good. https://howardfromgeorgia.com
